

## Connecting to Airbear – ANDROID

From your phone, open a web browser and go to:

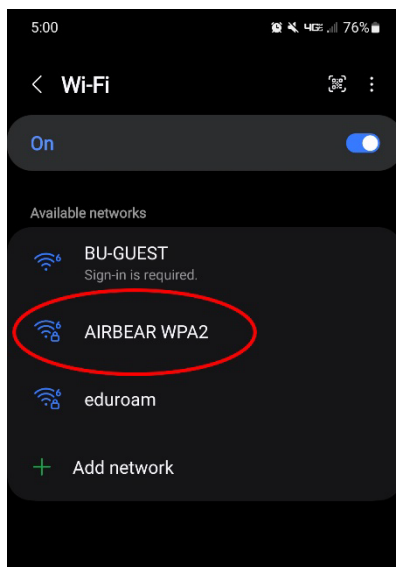
Under the Root Certificates section, click on Download for SHA-2 Root: USERTrust RSA Certification Authority

It should just download and save itself to your phone.

Now you can try to connect to Airbear following these instructions:

From your Settings, choose Connections, then Wifi.

Make sure it is ON, then select AIRBEAR WPA2



Type your **Bear\_Id** name (should be firstname\_lastname, without the @baylor.edu. Be sure to include the number if you have one at the end of your bear\_id).

Type your **Password**.

For CA certificate, choose: **System Certificates**

For Domain type: **baylor.edu**

If you want your device to Auto connect to Airbear anytime you are on campus, turn that option ON. You should be able to click **Connect** to join.

Note: for some models you may see additional options, the default options should be fine. The only other field we need to pay attention to is the **Anonymous Identity**, make sure it is **completely Blank**.
